We are committed to conserve energy, water and reduce hazardous & non-hazardous waste generation and take all possible steps to mitigate the risk of climate change.

In line with our sustainability vision, we endeavor to improve our energy efficiency in line with our EP-100 commitment. Maintain water positivity status and aim for zero waste to landfill & zero liquid discharge status across all our major manufacturing facilities by FY'35. Reduce our GHG scope-1&2 emissions by 37.5% from baseline year of FY'20 & target year of FY'35 align to our SBTi WB2DS target commitment.

We are committed to the following:

- Reduce specific energy consumption by moving towards energy efficient equipment, utilities and process modifications
- Support design activities that consider energy performance improvement
- Support the procurement of energy efficient products & services that impact energy performance
- Increase renewable energy usage to overall energy consumption for mitigating climate change impacts
- Reduce water consumption not only within our manufacturing facilities but also in the total life cycle of a product or service by adopting life cycle thinking at the design stage
- Protect local water sources that sustain communities. Replenish the water we use back to communities and nature.
- Implement access to safe water, sanitation and hygiene at the workplace at an appropriate level of standard for all our employees in all premises (WASH)
- Mitigate environmental risk through partnering with governments, NGOs and communities to assess, understand and chart effective, long-term water stress solutions, and implement source water protection plans
- Conserve natural resources and minimize the volume and possible environmental harm of the
 waste we generate in our factories and across our supply chain. We have crafted a detailed waste
 management policy that details our focus.
- Ensure the safe and secure handling, organization, and transportation of our raw materials, packaging materials and finished products
- Make use of natural or renewable materials, where practical, for design, production, packaging and transportation so long as they do not compromise the performance or safety of our products or services
- Follow waste management hierarchy Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Energy recovery, and Treatment & Disposal
- Encourage responsible production and sourcing practices by partnering with environmentally conscious stakeholders throughout our Value Chain.
- Promote tree plantation, green surrounding and protection of biodiversity at our manufacturing locations in harmony with nature
- Adopt life cycle thinking at the design stage to eliminate or reduce carbon emission, reduce water consumption and elimination of waste generation

- Adhere to all applicable Local / National / International laws of energy, water, waste effluent and solid waste management
- Train our team members on all aspects of energy, water & waste management relevant to their roles. We also strive to educate our suppliers, business partners, customers and stakeholders regarding the responsible handling and use of our raw materials & products

The policy applies to all GAVL business units, the entities we own and the entities in which we own a majority interest.

Across our diverse and extended supply chain, we prefer suppliers and business partners that have similar policies and practices and include relevant expectations in our contracts with them. For those suppliers who do not have similar policies and practices, we encourage and support them to do so. Active engagement and collaboration based on transparency, corrective action, and continuous improvement are hallmarks of our approach.

The Managing Director, supported by the Head – Good and Green, oversees our integrated environment management system. Board level oversight is provided by Board Management Committee and Board ESG Committee.
